HISRA is the result of a desire on the part of four park districts to provide quality recreation programs and services to individuals with disabilities and special needs. ### FOCUS = Ages: 18+

Come FOCUS on fun with friends! This program is for adults 18 years and older looking for an active way to spend their weekday. The group meets Monday through Thursday from 9AM to 3PM. Throughout the week we will enjoy grocery shopping, cooking, volunteering, exercising at the RiverPlex, exploring the surrounding communities, socializing with friends, playing games, and having fun! The program will meet daily at HISRA. However, Thursday provides a drop off and pick up option at Morton Freedom Hall. Some eligibility requirements do exist because of the level of activity.

#### **FOCUS Registration Information**

You are able to register for just one day a week or up to all four. The days you register for will be the days the participant attends FOCUS for the duration of the year. Based on program availability, registration can occur at anytime. However, annual priority registration is given to participants currently enrolled in FOCUS. This annual priority registration occurs at the beginning of each calendar year. In order to withdraw from FOCUS, a 30-day notice is required. Any withdrawal request will be processed and take effect the first program day of the month after the 30 days.

#### **FOCUS Payment Information**

A payment plan will be crafted for each participant based on the number of days for which he or she is registered. Payment for the month is due on the first business day of that month. A \$100 non-refundable down payment is required at the time of registration and will be applied to your first month's bill. The fees for FOCUS are \$37/day for residents and \$47/day for non-residents.

### Here's what you need to know!

#### **Forms Needed**

The following forms need to be completed to process your registration:

- 1. 2018 Annual Information Form and other applicable forms on file for participant - found at www.hirsra.org
- One of the following:
  - Full payment
  - Payment Plan (for balances more than \$200)
  - Scholarship application with all supporting documentation and 10% down payment (can be found at www.hisra.org)

#### **Registration Procedure**

- Log into your WebTrac account beginning at 8:30am on April 17, 2018 to register for all programming! If you need assistance creating or logging into your WebTrac account, see page 8.
- If you are unable to register online, you can register at the HISRA office beginning at 8:30am on April 17, 2018. Please be sure to bring the Registration Form on pages 9-10 if you choose to register in person.



#### Reminders

- The registration deadline for all programs is 2 weeks prior to the start date of the program.
- To cancel your registration for a program, 2 weeks notice is needed in order to process a refund for your account.

### **Registration Options**

#### **OPTION 1: WebTrac**

If you have participated in HISRA programs in 2018, you already have a WebTrac account and can register online for all Summer 2018 programs! If you need assistance logging into your account or registering using WebTrac, please contact us! WebTrac registration will open on April 17, 2018 at 8:30am!

If you do not yet have a WebTrac account, please see the instructions below to create an account and register online!

#### **WebTrac Account Creation**

Create a WebTrac account by following these instructions:

- 1. Go to https://webtrac.peoriaparks.org
- 2. Under "Account Login," select "Create an Account"
- 3. Create a login and password
- 4. Complete the "Household Primary Person Information" section. \*IMPORTANT: All existing addresses in the primary HISRA service area are pre-loaded in WebTrac. When completing the "Address 1" field, type only your house or apartment number and wait for the drop-down menu to appear. By selecting your address from the drop-down box, the system will be able to accurately determine your residency; if you enter your address without selecting an option from the drop-down menu, the system will default you to non-residency status.
  - Resident: This means you reside within Peoria Park District residency boundaries, and will receive resident rates for all Peoria Park District and HISRA programs.
  - PPD NR/HISRA RES: This means you live outside Peoria Park District residency boundaries, but within Chillicothe, Morton, or Washington Park District residency boundaries. This residency category will receive nonresident rates for Peoria Park District programs, but resident rates for HISRA programs.
  - Non-Resident: This means you live outside all of the above District boundaries, and will receive nonresident rates for all programs.
- 5. To add additional family members to your household, select the "Add New Member" button at the bottom of the screen.
- 6. To add an emergency contact, select the "Add Contact" button at the bottom of the screen. Typically, an emergency contact will be an individual that is not already included on the household account.

- 7. When all sections are complete, select "Save."
- 8. Make sure you are logged into your WebTrac account
- 9. From the WebTrac homepage, click the "SEARCH" option at the top of the page
- 10. From the drop down menu, choose "Activity Search"
- 11. Under "Type," choose "HISRA" and click "Search"
- 12. The result of the search will list all current HISRA programs for which you can register

#### **OPTION 2: Register in person at HISRA**

If you prefer not to register online or do not have the means to do so, you can register in person at HISRA beginning **April 17, 2018 at 8:30am** using the 2-page registration form found on pages 9-10. Registration will also be accepted by mail, but preference is given to walk in participants. Please note a 10% down payment will be required at the time of registration.
